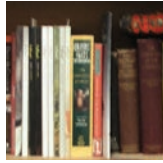

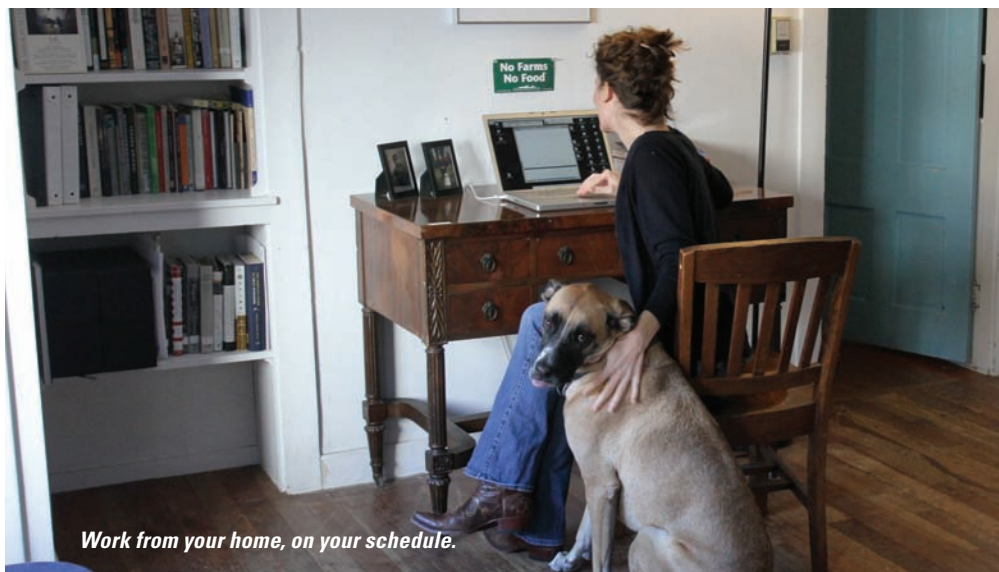

THE PROGRAM

24PearlStreet brings the Fine Arts Work Center's tradition of creative excellence and community to an online environment. The program runs in three seasons, in three genres, on three levels. Fall, Winter, and Spring. Poetry, Fiction, and Nonfiction. Introductory, Intermediate, and Intensive levels. Emphasizing the writing part of the online writing experience, 24PearlStreet offers a simple and engaging online space where you can focus on your teacher, your classmates, and your work.

THE SPECIFICS

- Prospective students view the workshop catalog and submit applications and writing samples online at www.fawc.org/24PearlStreet.
- Workshop faculty review the writing samples and select students.
- All workshops are capped at 15 students.
- Each workshop has its own online classroom—a blog where you can view assignments, post and read work, comment on your classmates' work, and receive comments about your work from your classmates and teacher.
- Students and teachers communicate via email and blog.

THE FACULTY

24PearlStreet gathers outstanding writers from across the country to design and lead online workshops that interest and excite your teachers and you. From developing the syllabus to selecting students to guiding workshop participation and providing criticism, the faculty is fully engaged. All workshops honor the Fine Arts Work Center's ethic of community and excellence.

The Fine Arts Work Center was founded in the late '60s by a group of artists, writers and patrons who believed that the freedom to pursue creative work within a community of peers is the best catalyst for artistic growth. The Work Center also offers its popular Summer Workshops in Creative Writing and the Visual Arts, and a unique low-residency Visual Arts MFA in collaboration with MassArt.

APPLICATION & SELECTION PROCESS


Applying to 24PearlStreet is an easy, online process.

- 1** Review the current workshop catalog and faculty biographies at www.fawc.org/24PearlStreet, and find a workshop you would like to join.
- 2** Complete the online application form.
- 3** Submit a writing sample for the faculty to review.

Accepted students will be notified by email from the Program Coordinator. Payment is due after acceptance to the program, and no later than one week before the start of the workshop. A 10% discount is available for students of the Fine Arts Work Center's Summer Program.
