2008 Cape Resident Artist/Writer Scholarship Application

The Fine Arts Work Center in Provincetown is offering 20 scholarships to year-round residents of Orleans, Eastham, Wellfleet, Truro, and Provincetown. Cape Resident Scholarships are intended to assist members of the Outer Cape community who would be unable to attend classes at the Work Center without financial aid. Scholarship recipients will pay a nominal fee of \$100 toward the standard workshop fee (workshop fees range between \$600-\$725), and will be responsible for studio/materials fees. The 2008 Summer Program begins on June 15 and runs through August 22, with weeklong workshops in Creative Writing and the Visual Arts. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis until the 20 spaces are full; please note that priority is given to applicants who have not received funding in the past.
