2008 Edward Bangs Kelley and Elza Kelley Foundation Scholarship Application

Through a generous grant from the Edward Bangs Kelley and Elza Kelley Foundation, the Fine Arts Work Center in Provincetown is offering 7 scholarships for weeklong courses in Creative Writing and the Visual Arts to elementary and secondary educators on Cape Cod. Two scholarships will include accommodations at the Fine Arts Work Center; applicants who live on the Upper Cape between Falmouth and Orleans will get priority for this additional funding. Scholarship recipients will pay a nominal fee of \$100 toward the standard workshop fee (workshop fees range between \$600-\$725), and will be responsible for studio/materials fees.

Kelley Foundation Scholarships are intended to assist teachers who often don't have the time or the funds to pursue their own creative interests. The 2008 Summer Program begins on June 15 and runs through August 22, with weeklong workshops in Creative Writing and the Visual Arts.
